February 1: As African Heritage Month begins, pray for the African United Baptist Association and its ministries. February 8: During African Heritage Month, pray for courage and humility as churches address racism and pursue reconciliation. Ask God to heal wounds caused by injustice and to free us from fear, denial, or indifference. Pray that the Church would model repentance, equity, and reconciling love.

February 15: As Lent begins and African Heritage Month continues, pray for the next generation, especially within Black communities. Ask God to provide opportunities for growth, education, and leadership. Pray for young people discerning God's call, that they would respond with faith, joy, and obedience.

February 22: As African Heritage Month concludes, give thanks for the rich history, gifts, and contributions of Black communities. Pray for unity across cultures and for renewed imagination for a hope-filled future. Ask God to bring renewal to our neighbourhoods through the Good News of Jesus.
