Instead of running, or walking, or biking, or canoeing, I am simply going birding as I stroll around. Each week, we take an hour and a half to go somewhere in or near Amherst to wander and to be birders. Let me know if you have a place you'd like to go, and a certain day and time of day to go. For each different species of bird I (we) identify, I will donate \$1 to the CMB project, which is for food security this year. What will you do? And... on Sunday mornings, we decorate a birch tree with each species of bird we see.

Here is a summary of our results so far, for May.

- May 7, 9:00 am, Downtown Amherst 8 bird species, 3 people, 1 dog
- May 16, 9:00 am, Amherst Cemetery 7 bird species, 1 person
- May 22, 9:00 am, Fundy Winds Marsh 17 bird species, 1 person
- May 27, 11:00 am, Maccan Tidal Wetlands 13 bird species, 6 people

So far (in May) I have reported 45 different species of birds to <u>eBird.org</u>. The **first excursion** in **June** will be **Wednesday** the **4th** at **10 am**, carpooling out to Boat Launch Road.
